Minutes of the Special Board Meeting of Monday, November 9, 1981

CALL TO ORDER:

The special meeting of the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 512 was called to order by Chairman Barch on Monday, November 9, 1981, at 7:00 p.m., in the Board Room of the Administration Building, Algonquin and Roselle Roads, Palatine.

ROLL CALL:

CANVASS OF ELECTION:

Chairman Barch announced that the canvass of the election would commence. He requested that Mr. Bakas, Vice President of Administrative Services, explain the procedures for the canvass.

Mr. Bakas stated that the election of November 3 was the first one to be held under the new consolidation of elections law. Under the old system, there were 48 precincts in the Harper College district. Due to changes, the district now consists of 386 precincts. In order to expedite the canvass proceedings, Mr. Bakas stated that four groups would work simultaneously with the official results from the various townships covering all four counties.

Member Tomchek entered the meeting at 7:03 p.m.

Mr. Bakas noted that tabulation sheets of unofficial results have been provided to those in attendance. Members of the canvass teams will open, read and compare figures with the tabulation, noting any changes. Board members were invited to observe the team tables, if desired. Following completion, Board members will adopt the resolution declaring the official results of the election and an Abstract of Votes will be sent to each of the four county clerks and the State Board of Elections.

Member Munson entered the meeting at 7:40 p.m.

CANVASS OF ELECTION: (cont.)

At the completion of the canvass, the official totals were announced as follows: George F. Dasher--7,471 votes; Donald D. Torisky--7,502 votes; Kris Howard--10,975 votes; and John F. Polli--5,578 votes.

Member Malkowski moved, Member Klussmann seconded, the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CANVASS OF THE VOTES CAST AND PROCLAMATION OF RESULTS

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of November, 1981, there was held in and for Community College District No. 512, Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, State of Illinois, an election for the purpose of electing two (2) members to the College Board for the full term of four (4) years; and

whereas, the Board of Trustees (Ill. Rev. Stat., ch. 122, sec. 9-18) must within seven (7) days after the election, canvass the votes and proclaim the results (Ill. Rev. Stat., ch. 46, sec. 22-18); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees must immediately after the canvass of votes and proclamation of results transmit a signed copy or original duplicates of its completed Abstract of Votes to each election authority (County Clerks of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties) and to the State Board of Elections in sealed envelopes and endorse same as to show the contents of the package; and

WHEREAS, the election has been regularly called and held as provided by law and the certificates of results have been filed with the Secretary of the Board of Trustees and the certificates of results are now before this Board and have been canvassed.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Trustees of Community College District No. 512, Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, State of Illinois, as follows:

Section One: That the Board of Trustees finds the attached summary of votes cast for candidates at the election held in and for this College District on the 3rd day of November, 1981.
