We appreciate your interest in Harper students and invite you to list your open positions with us. Our online job board is available to current students, alumni, community members and employers at no cost.



RECRUITING POLICIES

To ensure the quality of our services and to better assist students, alumni and other users of our services, we have established recruiting policies in accordance with the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) and abide by the NACE Principles for Professional Practice.

To be qualified as an employer to use JPRC services:

- Employers must adhere to federal and Illinois state EEO guidelines
- Employers must not involve solicitation, posting of materials or sale of products or services

The following types of business may not use JPRC services:

- Multilevel marketing companies
- Third Party recruiters
- Home based businesses

JOB POSTING

Harper's online job management system, Hire a Hawk, is a free resource for you to post your open positions and search for resumes of qualified candidates.

JOB FAIRS

The JPRC provides small, industry-specific job fairs during the spring semester for employers to network with Harper students and alumni. Because there are limited spaces, job fairs fill up quickly. Check our website for upcoming job fairs and events.

JOB FLASHES

At the beginning of each month, job listings are pulled from Hire a Hawk according to major areas. These job listings are then printed and posted on an area of interest job board in locations where students have classes.

INTERNSHIPS

Internships are intended to be a learning experience that combines classroom knowledge and work experience. These learning experiences allow students the opportunity to become more qualified as a future employee in the student's area of study.

INTERNSHIP DETAILS

- An internship is a work-based learning experience closely aligned with the student's Area of Interest
- The length of an internship may vary. This is a shortterm commitment that depends on the employer's needs and the student's availability.
- All internships must adhere to the Fair Labor Standards Act
- Students must adhere to the minimum GPA requirements and adhere to Harper College's Student Code of Conduct

EMPLOYER CRITERIA

- For-profit companies typically pay interns at least minimum wage and we recommend each employer consult legal counsel before posting an unpaid internship
- Starting and ending dates must be defined upfront and included on your Employer Internship Application
- A job description is required, with any qualifications, course completions and technical skills
- Interns must receive supervision, feedback and performance evaluations by an appropriate/ designated employee

ON CAMPUS RECRUITING (OCR)

On Campus Recruiting gives employers the opportunity to recruit students for part-time or seasonal positions during the fall and spring semesters. A table is set up in a high-traffic area on campus to connect with students in an informal atmosphere. Register to attend one of our scheduled OCR dates by contacting the main office by phone or email.

TIPS FOR OCR

Employers are encouraged to bring suitable items to attract students' attention, such as:

- Applications
- Flyers
- Pamphlets
- Giveaways

You will need to get the student's attention; stand beside or in front of your table to help attract students. It is advisable that you not be on your phone as students walk by.

Know that the table is located in a high traffic area that is allowable by campus policy.

The JPRC will email you with directions to campus, where to park and check in. If you have many/heavy items, we recommend using a rolling cart.
