Strategic Goal Supported: Goal 3.2 (increase % of FTFT freshmen in credit-bearing courses)

Target Population (Who will be impacted and how many people will be involved?): *High school juniors from Palatine High School. High achieving students typically African American and Hispanic. Approximately 20-25 students total*

Brief description of strategy: Project Excel is a two-week program that Harper College has agreed to provide for students from Palatine High School that have just completed their junior year of high school. The students will experience two different simulated college courses (SOC 101 & PSY 107) during their time at Harper as well as be introduced to a variety of college services. The intent of this project is to improve college readiness skills and improve knowledge and confidence in accessing college services that will aid in college success.

Expected Outcomes (What change do you expect as a result of this strategy?): Project Excel is designed for high performing underrepresented high school juniors that have taken accelerated and AP courses however, they may not be fully prepared for the rigors of college coursework. This strategy will support the above mentioned goal by giving these students exposure to college via simulated courses, a library research assignment, and engagement with faculty and staff on Harper's campus. This experience will give them the opportunity to examine their college readiness skills and provide time for them to address any deficiencies in coursework or self-awareness skills during their senior year of high school. This will hopefully lead to them being able to enroll in credit-bearing courses during their freshmen year of college.
