Goal Supported:

Decrease student achievement gaps of developmental, young male and black non-Hispanic students, while increasing academic achievement for all.

Target Population (Who will be impacted and how many people will be involved?): Students who graduate in the bottom half of their high school class and place into at least two developmental courses or sequence of developmental courses.

Brief description of strategy: This intervention is for students who graduated in the bottom half of their class in high school and tested into at least two developmental courses or a sequence of developmental courses. This program focus is on a structured support system that assists the student with academic success and in maneuvering through the College system. Particular emphasis in this intervention is on students of color.

Expected Outcomes (What change do you expect as a result of this strategy?):

- Increase the success rate for students who enroll in at least two developmental courses or sequence of courses.
- Increase the progression of developmental students through the developmental sequence.
- Increase the number of students who move on to and succeed in gatekeeper courses.
- Increase the percent of students who complete the courses they take with a grade of C or higher.
- Increase the percent of students who re-enroll from one semester to the next.
