



CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT

Learn basic care skills for patient well-being in healthcare facilities.

- Schedule Options

 - B) September-December 2016, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5-9 p.m., plus a mandatory 40-hour clinical internship (weekend)



EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION ASSISTANT TEACHER CERTIFICATE

Build skills in basic early childhood care and education. Qualify for assistant teacher roles in licensed child care facilities.




