"Third place" is a term coined by sociologist Ray Oldenburg and refers to places where people spend time between home ('first' place) and work ('second' place).










Third places help to provide buffers against stress, loneliness, inactivity, and alienation. They are locations where we exchange ideas, have a good time, and build relationships.

#### **GATE COUNT**








## Teaching in the Library








## Equity-Driven Collection Initiatives

#### Fall 2024


- 90 online textbooks purchased

- \$13,650 Library cost




### Study Rooms

- Workshops through Community Education




