

Information You'll Need to Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA

A *contributor* is a new term on the 2024-2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). A contributor is anyone who is required to provide consent and approval to have their federal tax information transferred directly from the IRS into the FAFSA form and provide a signature on the form. A contributor is:

- You, the student, and, if applicable, contributors may also include,
- · Your spouse,
- · Your parent,
- · Your parent's spouse or partner

Starting with the 2024-2025 FAFSA, you and each contributor will need to create a StudentAid.gov account to enter information and complete their section of the FAFSA. This will create an FSA ID (username and password) that is used to electronically sign the FAFSA.

<u>Each contributor will need to enter information and complete their section of the FAFSA.</u> Contributors who do not have a social security number are able to create an account for the 2024-2025 FAFSA by following the instructions and prompts to create a StudentAid.gov account.
