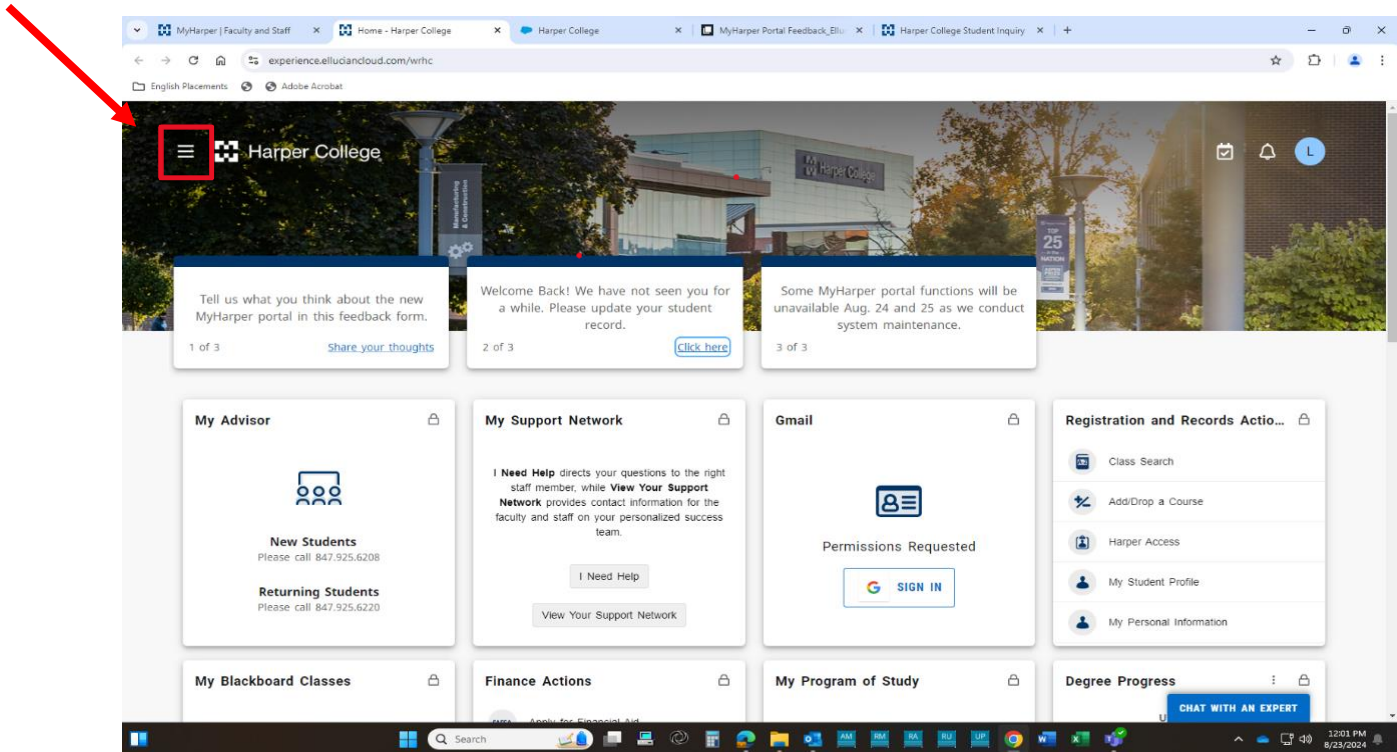

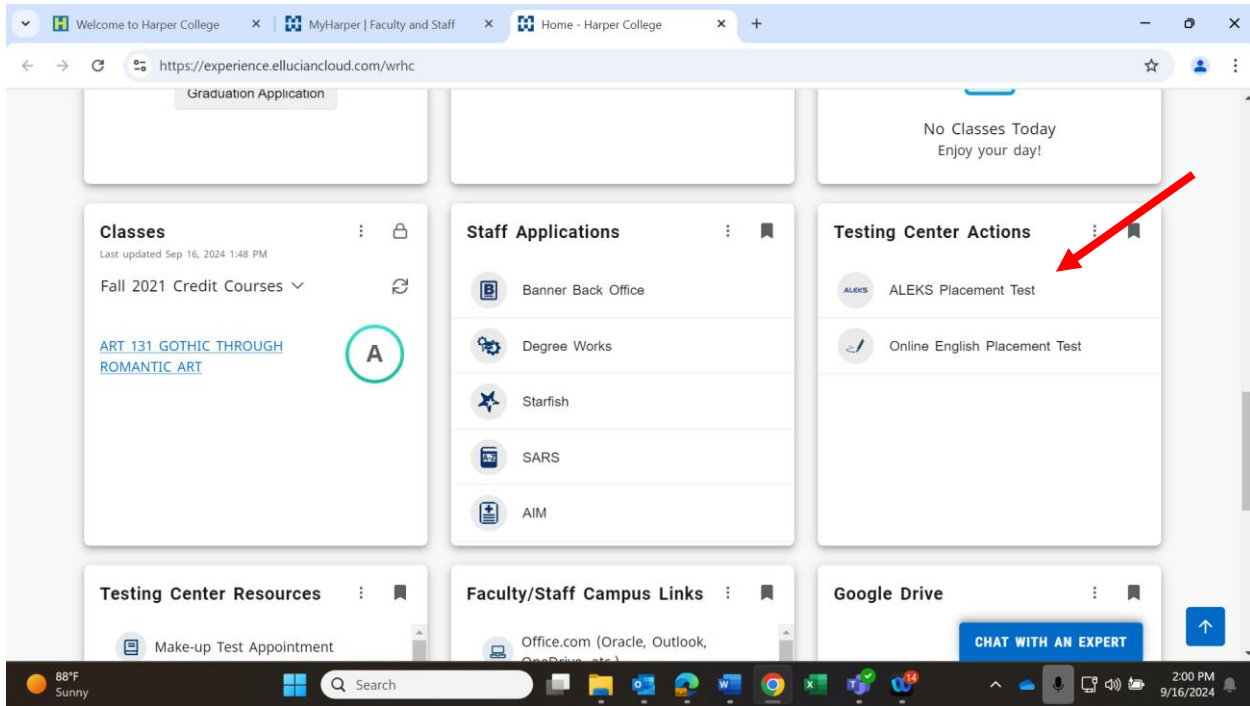

## Directions for students to access their Aleks Preview Test:

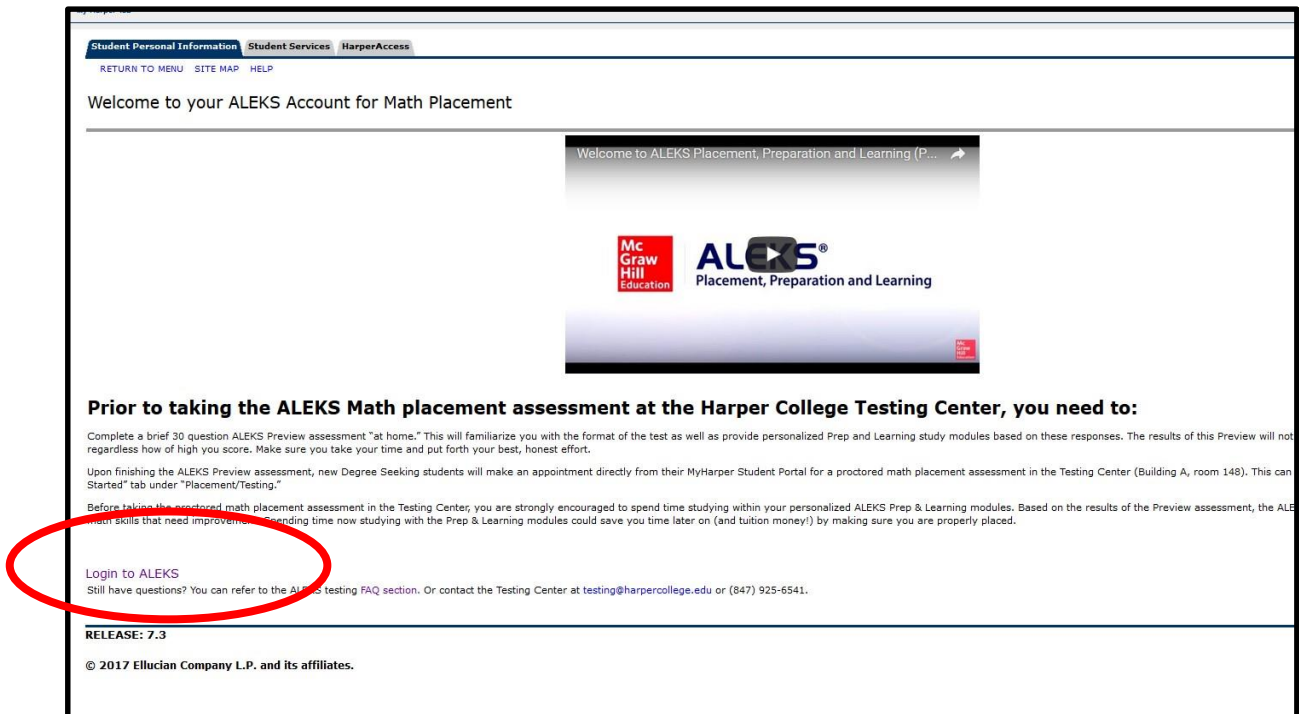
1. After logging into your student portal, click on the Main Menu


