



Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement
June 15, 2011

1. **Degree Granting Institution:** University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Bachelor of Applied Studies/Fire and Emergency Response Management Emphasis
2. **Transfer Institution:** Harper College (Palatine, IL) Associate in Applied Science, Fire Science Technology
3. **Effective date:** Fall Semester 2011
4. **Review date:** This agreement will be reviewed in Fall 2016 or sooner should affected requirements change at either program.
5. **Explanation and rationale:** This agreement establishes an educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and Harper College in order to expand the opportunities for their graduates to complete a bachelors degree.
6. Harper College students who have successfully completed the above program will be awarded 42 credits in block, based on related technical coursework (see below), which will be applied to the BAS/FERM degree with UW Oshkosh. Credits for other courses may be considered for transfer by UW Oshkosh on a case-by-case basis.
7. Block credits will be awarded based on successful completion of the following at Harper College:

- The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Bachelor of Applied Studies FERM degree program at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BAS FERM may encounter additional program requirements.
- Students from the above-mentioned Harper College program must have successfully completed their Associate degree (fulfilling all course work stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. The terms of this agreement do **not** apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for this Associate degree.
